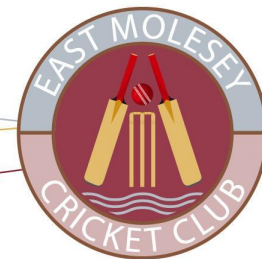


# East Molesey Cricket Club



## Head Groundsperson

**Location:** East Molesey Cricket Club, Graburn Way, KT8 9AL

**Salary:** Competitive salary, commensurate with experience

East Molesey Cricket Club is located alongside the south bank of the River Thames half a mile from Hampton Court Palace. Founded in 1871, it is a thriving local sports club with a long and glorious history. The Club's 1st XI are current Surrey Championship Premier Division champions. There are five senior Saturday sides competing in the Surrey Championship as well as a junior program with over 600 boys and girls from U5 through to U19.

**The Role** - We seek a full-time candidate who, amongst other things, will:

- Maintain and prepare our 17-wicket square and outfield to a high premier-league standard
- Be responsible for pitch planning an extensive schedule of cricket throughout the summer.
- Arrange/manage the wicket covering process throughout the summer.
- Be available for weekend cricket matches as/when required.
- Maintain all outside areas, including outbuildings, footpaths, cricket nets, car park, hedges and trees.
- Liaise with suppliers to order products & supplies when required.
- Ensure equipment is maintained & serviced.
- (If acquired) take on the maintenance & preparation of a second (smaller) cricket square in close proximity to our main ground.

**The Candidate** - To be considered for our Head Groundsman position, we are looking for candidates who take pride in the role of producing high-quality playing surfaces alongside the upkeep of the surroundings to the highest possible standard. Candidates should be organised and proactive, remain calm in a busy and demanding environment, demonstrate excellent communication skills, and possess a flexible attitude to working hours (prepared to work weekends and bank holidays as required). The following skills, qualifications and experience are desirable:

- Extensive knowledge and experience of cricket squares.
- Be able to undertake and own the process of end-of-season repairs.
- The ability to use their own initiative to identify and fix problems.
- Awareness and adherence to relevant Health and Safety legislation.
- A flexible approach to the working day.
- A high attention to detail and organisation.
