



Player/Coach (Junior Head Coach)

Ashtead CC is a thriving and progressive cricket club at the heart of the local community based in Surrey. The senior section 1st and 2nd XI's play in their respective AJ Fordham Surrey Championship Premier Leagues and 3rd XI division 1. The 4th XI plays in the Surrey Downs League and the Club arranges friendly 5th and 6th XI fixtures when availability allows. Ashtead also has a Sunday XI, playing in the VCL, and has a team in the Surrey Trust Academy League.

The Club has a thriving Junior Section, with around 450 cricketers aged between 5 and 18 (with waiting lists at the younger end), playing in the Surrey Junior Cricket Championship. The Club's Girls' Section has over 100 players and teams compete in the Local Leagues and Festivals at U9, U11, U13, U15 and U17. Currently the Club has a number of boys and girls in the Surrey CCC Performance programs from U9 through to U17.

The Club has Clubmark status and is a Surrey Focus Club. In 2014 it reached the National Finals Day of the NatWest Club T20 Competition, finishing runners-up out of the 800 clubs starting the competition. The club is also very proud of the fact that current England Test opener, Dom Sibley, played Junior and Senior cricket at Ashtead CC and still has a close association with the Club.

The Role / Opportunity:

We are seeking candidates for the Junior Head Coach role of our thriving junior section. Reporting to the Director of Cricket, the Player Coach will be involved in specific responsibility for developing junior players across a number of age groups.

The role would also incorporate a playing responsibility for Ashtead CC (ideally at 1st XI level) although we would consider non playing coach applications.

Responsibilities

- Winter Junior Training Sessions - we are looking for a coach to plan and lead a 10-week program on Sundays from Jan to March 2022 across a number of age groups.
- Junior training Monday to Friday for 14 weeks throughout the junior season April to July 2022. Actively plan, participate and direct a team of coaches.
- Support the Director of Cricket in the development and structure of the junior section with some administrative and partnership-building responsibilities.

- Holiday Camps – we run successful camps throughout the year.
