As the Performance Pathway Batting Coach you will lead on batting coaching across the performance pathway. Your focus will primarily be on the Academy and Emerging Players Programme (EPP) but there will also be an expectation to be aware of players within the County Age Group (CAG) teams.

The vision for Lancashire Cricket is to become the best place to enjoy cricket in the world. A key pillar of Lancashire Cricket's strategy is to build strong elite Teams (Men's and Women's) that can win tournaments, with a minimum of seven players being developed from the local pathway. This position will therefore play an integral role in working towards these objectives.

In addition to the performance pathway, you will also provide support to the professional playing staff as directed by the Head Coach.

Given the nature of the role, evening and weekend working will be required and you may also be required to travel with the squad for matches and overseas training.

We're ideally looking for somebody who has a minimum UKCC3 qualification or international equivalent and a desire to embrace the latest coaching techniques. You will bring with you comprehensive and proven coaching experience and a strong ability to work collaboratively as part of a wider coaching team.

This is an exciting opportunity that will see you working in a club with an enviable history and heritage that has been a first-class county since 1864 and has the world class international venue of Emirates Old Trafford as its centre of excellence and performance hub. You will also be working across an extremely large and diverse area as Lancashire Cricket covers all elite and recreational cricket across the North-West from North Wales up to Scotland.

### **The Role and Responsibilities**

The role of Performance Pathway Batting Coach will be integral role in the coaching team and will include:

- Coaching and developing Batters across the Academy, EPP and pathway.
- Supporting the professional team as requested by the Head Coach
- Managing and updating player feedback and analysis
- Liaising with the Head Coach, Head of Talent Pathway, medical department and rest of the coaching team on performance of individual players and their suitability for relevant selections
- Working closely with the club Analyst to aid building of development plans

### **Requirements**

The ideal candidate will have:

- Batting coaching experience with a county pathway or professional team
- Minimum UKCC3 coaching qualification (although Level 4 would be desirable) or international equivalent
- ECB Coaches Association membership
- Enhanced DBS Check/Certificate
